Technology Equipment Agreement

In the effort to maximize student learning during the hybrid or potential extended school closure, Bond County CUSD #2 is agreeing to loan the Parent/Guardian, further referred to as The Undersigned, the device listed below. The District's technology equipment is to be used as a productivity tool for school-related work, curriculum enhancement, research, and communications.

The Student shall exercise appropriate judgment and common sense when using the District's technology equipment. All devices are District property and are provided to the student during the hybrid or potential school closure. The undersigned agrees to return the device back to the school either when 2020-2021 school year resumes or June 1, 2021, whichever happens first. As a condition of their use of the school's technology equipment, students and the undersigned must comply with and agree to all the following:

- The Student will still maintain and agree to the district policies as outlined in the student handbook.
- The Student is expected to have this equipment with them and charged daily to perform their school work as assigned by their teachers.
- The Student should NOT modify any of the configurations set by the District, nor remove any profiles installed.
- The Student and the Undersigned are expected to protect school technology equipment from damage or theft at all times.
- The Undersigned may be monetarily responsible for any hardware or software damage that may occur due to negligence.
- The Student and Undersigned are reminded that the equipment may have camera capabilities. Storing personal photos, videos, and documents on the equipment is prohibited. The use of the camera should be limited to curriculum related tasks, classroom meetings, etc.
- Equipment should not be used near water, sand, snow, rain, food, or liquid.
- The Student and Undersigned understand that filtering of websites is not the responsibility of Bond County CUSD #2 while the device is loaned out.
