To all BCCU2 Families,

Over the past several months, we have been planning for the start of the 2020-2021 school year. It has been a challenging process that often resulted in more questions than answers. Throughout the entire process, the safety of students and staff has been a priority, while meeting the social emotional and educational needs of our students. We also know there is no substitute for quality in person instruction and anything less than “normal” is not ideal. We fully acknowledge this uncertainty has been challenging for families who are trying to plan around schedules given their various personal situations.

As we continue to plan, we do so doing our best to adhere to guidance from the CDC, IDPH, and ISBE. We are also monitoring local and regional data related to COVID-19 while being in constant contact with the Bond County Health Department and local officials.

After continued deliberation, we have decided to start the year in a hybrid model which combines in person instruction with remote learning. In addition, many families have elected for the online learning only format. We will start in the hybrid model and re-evaluate after Labor Day, to determine if we can safely move to 5 day week in person, remain hybrid, or be remote only, if directed to do so for safety reasons. We are urging parents to prepare for all three options at any given time, as health data will drive the district’s decision on which learning format we are in, at any given time.

To meet instructional needs associated with remote learning and comply with safety guidance, we must alter the daily schedule. The schedules will be applicable whether we are in a hybrid or 5 day a week model. It is unlikely we return to our “normal” schedules until we are in Phase 5 of the Restore Illinois Plan.

Individual students’ schedules will be finalized no later than August 7th. Building principals will be sharing and building specific information in coming weeks as well information about district provided transportation. Please understand that we will do our best to accommodate and schedule families on the same schedules. For students with IEP’s, attendance schedules may vary based on student need and details of the IEP. For questions about special education services, please contact our special education department.

As we approach the start of the school year, face coverings (masks) are required for students and district employees at all times during the school day unless they are eating or outside. In order to help students prepare for this requirement, please begin having your child(ren) practice wearing a mask at home. This will aid in their transition back to school.

We know this is not an easy time for our students and families. We will continue to do our best to provide for the safety of our students and staff while meeting the social, emotional and academic needs of all our students. We all want to get back to “normal”. We ask that we work together through these difficult times to get there.
