

BCCU2 Online Learning General Information For K-8th Grade Students

Good evening parents/guardians of online learners! Below is some general information regarding what online learning will look like for your child as well as some expectations.

There are six district teachers who will be providing online instruction to students in grades K-8.

Students will be expected to complete online work assigned by his/her teacher each day school is held, based on the district calendar. Attendance will be taken daily and grades will be given for assignments and assessments. If your child is sick and unable to complete the assigned daily work, please notify your child's teacher via email.

K-3rd grade students will be taught the same curriculum as students who opted in-person learning. Teachers will utilize Google Classroom, websites, and videos to teach the content. Students will meet with their teacher and classmates on a regular basis via Google Meets.

4th-8th grade students will be taught curriculum through Edgenuity, which is an online curriculum that aligns to state standards. Students will be given instruction through this program and their teacher will provide assignments daily for students to complete. In addition, teachers will utilize other resources to provide instruction to their students, which will include Google Classroom, websites, and videos to teach the content. Students will meet with their teacher and classmates on a regular basis via Google Meets.

On Monday, August 17th, 4th-8th grade students are encouraged to come to GJH to meet their teacher and receive additional information and some materials. Please see the attached flyer that provides more details.

On Thursday, August 20th and Friday, August 21st, Kindergarten - 3rd grade students are encouraged to come to the Office of Student Services building, located directly behind BCCU2 High School to meet their teacher and receive additional information and some materials.
